It tells the story of a child called Emily and her first visit to Pioneer Farm. She soon finds out that there is more to farm life than she expected. When she accidentally steps on some barnyard poo she becomes quite upset and the animals living there come to her aid and offer their advice. The llamas, the peacock, the goat and sheep as well as the chickens, pigs and horses each add their own spin as to how her dilemma should be handled. Their individual and unique personalities shine through as they try to help. Her journey eventually leads to a wise little donkey who shares his simple message and guides her to the understanding that poo is an extremely important ingredient for farming and helps her accept that what she thought was a huge problem was really just a part of normal everyday farm life. Today there is a growing disconnect between the awareness of how food is grown and where it comes from. This book in a relaxed and fun way dispels some of those unknowns and will create bases for more learning.
